- Successfully transitioned to new leadership for Liberty Alliance
- Changed name to better reflect key principles and geographic scope
- Had articles in Indian Hill Living and Indian Hill Journal about name change
- Reformatted the home page of our Web site with new layout and logo
- Implemented planning process (including member survey) to determine objectives in 2012 and 2013

- Developed Grapevine as widely-read publication in tea party movement
- Developed and participated in presentation to major donors to fund permanent structure for tea party movement in Ohio
- Recruited candidate to run for Indian Hill School Board
- Participated in Indian Hill Fourth of July parade
- Attended We the People Convention in Columbus
- Participated on Hamilton County School Levy Board
- Participated as board member of the Ohio Liberty Council
- Attended hearings on Williams/Hunter election recount
- Gathered petition signatures for Estate Tax repeal

 - Held a fundraiser for Issue 3 and raised over \$6,000
 - Wrote op-ed on Issue 3 published in six newspapers throughout the state
 - Wrote op-ed on Issue 3 co-authored with Ed Meese and published by Politico
 - Participated in three local forums on Issue 3
 - Participated in 45 minute debate on Issue 3 on NPR in Cleveland

- Efforts relating to public union collective bargaining reform (SB5):
 - Attended rallies in Columbus in support of SB5
 - Attended Ohio Senate hearings on SB5

- Efforts relating to the constitutional challenge to the Obamacare individual health care mandate:
 - Published op-eds in the Washington Times and the Cincinnati Enquirer on the unprecedented nature of the individual mandate

 - Debated constitutionality of individual mandate in three other forums, including We the People Convention in Columbus and assembly of 400 students at Indian Hill High School

 - Wrote an analysis on the constitutionality of the individual mandate that has gotten attention nation-wide by legal scholars
 - Quoted extensively in a Cincinnati Enquirer article on the Sixth Circuit lawsuit challenging the individual mandate
 - Rallied outside the 6th Circuit Court House for hearings on constitutionality of Obamacare
- Wrote letters to the editor on various topics
- Participated in “liberty lobby” effort (attended meetings with Jeanne Schmidt and Rob Portman as part of that effort)
- Participated in tax day Rally in Glendale
- Get out the vote effort for November 2011 elections:
